

### Directions to Venue:

**From M1 at junction 24**, take A6 and at Zouch turn left onto A6006, then LEFT at traffic lights, just after Rempston, onto A60 Loughborough Rd: The show will be signposted when you get near to the venue: **GO OVER the roundabout at Mere Way and LEFT at the next set of lights into Ruddington Village**: *Turn LEFT at the X-Roads in the village - Follow signs which take you around the back of the park on a minor road until you see signs for the show area after the railway crossing.*

**From A52 past Radcliff-on-Trent**, TURN LEFT at roundabout onto Lings Bar Rd just before the 'Bridge at Gamston' restaurant, toward Ruddington - TURN RIGHT at roundabout taking A606 towards Nottingham – keep in LEFT hand lane through lights on Island – TURN LEFT at next roundabout onto A60, Loughborough Rd then soon **TURN RIGHT at Lights into Ruddington Village – FOLLOW ABOVE DIRECTIONS IN ITALICS.**

### HOT WEATHER WARNING and Help

Your dog is vulnerable and is at risk during hot weather and the Kennel Club offers the following guidance to help guide you through the do's and don'ts travelling to and whilst at this show

# When travelling to a show take a moment to consider whether the route to the show is on a busy holiday route, and leave earlier to avoid time in traffic jams

# If your vehicle is not air-conditioned seriously consider whether travelling to the show is a good idea at all

# The vehicle should be as fully ventilated as possible, and plenty of stops should be taken, with lots of water available to drink

# Ensure your dog is not sitting in direct sunlight. There should be plenty of free flowing air around the dog

# When at the show never leave your dog in the vehicle

# Keep the dog in the shade – take your own shade, for example, a large umbrella and always have plenty of water available to drink to keep your dog well hydrated

# Avoid your dog taking part in unnecessary exertion or from standing in exposed sunlight for extended lengths of time

Remember. If you feel hot your dog is very likely to feel much hotter and dehydrated and this could lead to dire results. Please look after your dog's welfare
